A double-blind peer review process is applied for abstract selection by an expert review panel. Abstracts are selected on merit. Studies in progress are welcome for poster presentation. Early bird registration fees will apply for delegates who have their abstracts accepted.

Authors of accepted presentations will be notified of acceptance via e-mail communication by the 15 August 2022.

Completed and finalised abstracts and virtual poster must be submitted no later than 30 August 2022.
