## ASBESTOS ABATEMENT REGULATIONS, 2020

The Minister of Employment and Labour has, under section 43 of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, 1993 (Act No. 85 of 1993), made the following amendments to the Asbestos Abatement Regulations in the Schedule as published in Notice No. 1196, in Gazette No.43893, published on 10 November 2020 as follows:

"OEL for asbestos" means an occupational exposure limit of 0,1 regulated asbestos fibres per millilitre of air over a continuous period of four hours measured in accordance with HSG 248;

Regulation 7 (4) (a): be provided by a competent person; deemed competent by the chief inspector:;

Regulation 10 (5) – The relevant Chief Director: Provincial Operations must ensure that acknowledgement of receipt is provided, in writing, to the employer, self-employed person or asbestos client within the seven day notification period.

Regulation 13 (e) receive acknowledgement from the Chief Director: Provincial Operations within the seven day period:
