#### JOB PURPOSE

To provide an effective Occupational, Primary Health Care and Emergency medical service to all SAAT Technical employees and contractors to comply with the provisions of Occupational Health and Safety Act 85 of 1993 and other inherent legislations.

## PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTABILITIES

- A) Occupational Health
  - 1. Identify Health Risks inherent to work activities in the workplace and the impact on health of employees.
  - 2. Compile the occupational risk profile and medical surveillance.
  - 3. Perform operational (technical and biological) calibration on medical screening equipment before use to comply with relevant SANS quality standard to obtain accurate, correct and reliable results.
  - 4. Conduct pre-employment, periodical, transfer and exit medical examination as per medical surveillance plan as stipulated by OHS Act 85 of 1993 to prevent development of occupational diseases i.e.:
    - a. Audiometry test
    - b. Lung function test
    - c. Vision screening
    - d. Biological monitoring etc.
- B) Prevention of communicable diseases for employees exposed to hygiene and biological hazards
  - 1. Arrange and administer relevant vaccine and prophylaxis treatment.
  - 2. Conduct pre-travel health counselling and issue travel bags and kits.
  - 3. Conduct facility inspections to ensure adequate housekeeping standards according to Regulatory requirements.
  - 4. Perform inspection of food processing and consumption areas to ensure compliance to Food Safety Standards.
- C) Emergency Medical Services
  - 1. Provide immediate emergency services to stabilize the condition of SAAT employees and contractors to prevent complications of injuries-on-duty.
  - 2. Ensure emergency equipment and consumables are available and up to date.
  - 3. Process referral to other medical institutions and complete relevant documentation i.e. COID.
  - 4. Participate in root cause analysis for injuries and occupational diseases to provide medical aspect.
  - 5. Provide and replenish first aid boxes, biohazard waste kits, bird strike kits and burn shield kits for all work areas according to legislation etc.

D) Provision of Primary Health Care Service to identify occupational related conditions and prevent complications of chronic medical conditions to all employees

- 1. Assess, diagnose and prescribe relevant treatment.
- 2. Refer complicated cases to an Occupational Medical Practitioner (OMP), Employee Wellbeing department, Local Primary Health Care Clinics or other Medical Institutions.
- 3. Provide professional health advice, guidance and promotion.
- 4. Process medical reports and specialist bookings as per the OMP's directive.

E) Drug control program to comply with the Medicine Control Act

- 1. Ensure accurate record of drugs and medical supplies for stock balance.
- 2. Ensure safe disposal of pharmaceutical and bio-hazard waste according to prescribed regulatory requirements.
- F) Administration, record keeping and Statistical Reporting
  - 1. Compile Primary Health, medical surveillance, injury on duty and laboratory tests information for Management reports.
  - 2. Assist the OMP to compile ill-health and sick absenteeism report.
  - 3. Update employee files and drug registers
